PREFACE

When I first started pastoring years ago, I sought to answer the question: **what is the gospel of Jesus Christ according to the Scriptures?** By the grace of God and for the glory of Jesus Christ, this workbook (formerly called *Essential Christian Doctrines*) is the result of 20 years of searching the Scriptures in striving to answer this essential question.

This workbook focuses on the teachings of Jesus Christ regarding His gospel, which He revealed entirely to His disciples through the Holy Spirit. According to the Scriptures, the gospel of Jesus Christ reveals the righteousness and the work of God. Therefore, believing in the gospel of Jesus Christ must include believing in what God has done in Christ, through Christ, and for Christ so that salvation and eternal life can be offered to all and granted to everyone who believes. My prayer is that God will use this workbook to lead you in reverently and biblically answering for yourself: what is the gospel of Jesus Christ?

Our ministry's vision is to restore the honor and glory to Jesus Christ as first love of His messengers, as first place in His church, and as first importance of His gospel. We will be traveling around Philippines from church to church to offer free Bible training primarily to pastors and teachers who have not been afforded formal Bible education. The training focuses on two subjects: Christ-centered gospel and Christ-centered Bible interpretation. 

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


WORKBOOK GUIDE (cont.)

Features:

- **1 LESSON.** Each lesson contains one main point that's intended to be studied in one sitting, if possible.
- 2 **KEY WORDS** are bolded in the Main Passage. The definitions of words are derived from the original language of the Bible and are taken from Hebrew/ Aramaic dictionaries (if Old Testament) or Greek dictionaries (if New Testament).
- **3 SUPPORTING VERSES.** All the verses listed are equally important. Students are encouraged to look up all Scriptures references in their own Bibles. If a passage is written as a reference only, or has a "..." anywhere, it means that the entire passage could not fit on the page so open your Bible. If any portion of the passage is underlined, that is the truth being highlighted for that lesson.
- **4 MAIN POINT.** This main point is based on all the verses listed in the lesson. The underlined words are blanks in the Student Workbook.

Believing in the gospel of Jesus Christ according to the Scripture is the power of God for salvation and the only way people <u>CAN AND MUST</u> be saved.

"Now I make **known** to you, brethren, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain. For the wrath of God is <u>revealed</u> from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, <u>because that which is known about God is</u> <u>evident within them; for God made it evident to them</u>. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that <u>they are without excuse</u>."

God's revelation through the gospel of Jesus Christ:

"And He, <u>when He comes</u>, <u>will convict the world concerning sin</u> and righteousness and judgment; <u>concerning</u> <u>sin</u>, <u>because they do not believe in Me</u>; and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged."

God's revelation to unborn children: Luke 1:39-44

GOSPEL TRUTH

The <u>EXCUSE</u> of not knowing God is impossible because God makes Himself known to every person ever conceived or born. Therefore, a person can only either reject, deny, or believe what God revealed and continues to reveal which is ultimately the gospel of Jesus Christ according to the Scriptures.

Lesson 6 | Introduction

MAIN PASSAGES

1 Corinthians 15:1-5

"Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel... For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that **Christ** died for our sins according to the Scriptures..."

1 John 3:16

"We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren."

1 Corinthians 15:1-5

"Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel... For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that **Christ** died for our sins according to the Scriptures..."

Philippians 2:5-11

"Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He **humbled** Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is **Lord**, to the glory of God the Father."

For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ."

According to the Scriptures, our faith in Jesus Christ and our preaching of Jesus Christ must be according to the <u>BIBLE</u>.

GOSPEL TRUTH

The content of His gospel must solely be based on the teachings of <u>GOD</u>, otherwise, the teachings are futile or in vain because they are either of people or of demons.

Saving faith is believing in what <u>GOD</u> teaches about the person and works of Jesus Christ which is revealed in His gospel according to the Scriptures.





For indeed Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom; but <u>we preach Christ crucified</u>, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness, but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God."



He is Risen, Just as it is Written

Lesson 2 | The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

MAIN PASSAGE

John 20:24-31

"But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe." After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then He said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing." Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed? Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed." Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these have been written so that you may **believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name."

Lesson 8: Adoption | The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

MAIN PASSAGE

Romans 8:1-17

"Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death... For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of **adoption** as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are <u>children of God</u>, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him."

Ephesians 2:1-7

"And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the <u>sons of disobedience</u>. Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature <u>children of wrath</u>, even as the rest. But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, <u>made us alive together</u> with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus."

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has **blessed** us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in <u>the Beloved</u>."

Lesson 14: Future Glorification | The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

MAIN PASSAGE

Philippians 3:7-21

"But whatever things were gain to me, those things I have counted as loss for the sake of Christ. More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ, and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith, that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death; in order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead. Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus. Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Let us therefore, as many as are perfect, have this attitude; and if in anything you have a different attitude, God will reveal that also to you; however, let us keep living by that same standard to which we have attained. Brethren, join in following my example, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us. For many walk, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, that they are enemies of the cross of Christ, whose end is destruction, whose god is their appetite, and whose glory is in their shame, who set their minds on earthly things. For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ; who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself."

So then, brethren, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh— for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be **glorified** with Him. For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us."



For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that **Christ** died for our sins **according to the Scriptures**, and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve."

If we receive the testimony of men, the testimony of God is greater; for the testimony of God is this, that He has testified concerning His Son. "For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in; and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, "The Deliverer will come from Zion, He will remove ungodliness from Jacob. This is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins." From the standpoint of the gospel they are enemies for your sake, but from the standpoint of God's choice they are beloved for the sake of the fathers; for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. For just as you once were disobedient to God, but now have been shown mercy because of their disobedience, so these also now have been disobedient, that because of the mercy shown to you they also may now be shown mercy. For God has shut up all in disobedience so that He may show mercy to all. Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How **unsearchable** are His judgments and **unfathomable** His ways!"

"The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of **faith** which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; for "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved." How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news of good things!" However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ."

First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, because your faith is being proclaimed throughout the whole world. For God, whom I serve in my spirit in the preaching of the gospel of His Son, is my witness as to how unceasingly I make mention of you, always in my prayers making request, if perhaps now at last by the will of God I may succeed in coming to you. For I long to see you so that I may impart some spiritual gift to you, that you may be established; that is, that I may be encouraged together with you while among you, each of us by the other's faith, both yours and mine. I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that often I have planned to come to you (and have been prevented so far) so that I may obtain some fruit among you also, even as among the rest of the Gentiles. I am under obligation both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish. So, for my part, I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome. For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "But the righteous man shall live by faith."



For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins **according to the Scriptures**, and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve."

For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast."

But God exercised His <u>FREEWILL</u> and sovereignly chose to save some people. Therefore, people are condemned because they chose to reject God. But Christians are saved because God chose them: God's gracious choice!



"Only conduct yourselves in a manner **worthy** of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; in no way alarmed by your opponents—which is a sign of destruction for them, but of salvation for you, and that too, from God."

2 Corinthians 4:1-6

"Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we received mercy, we do not lose heart, but we have renounced the things hidden because of shame, not walking in craftiness or adulterating the word of God, but by the manifestation of truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the **glory** of Christ, who is the image of God. For we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the **glory** of God in the face of Christ."
