

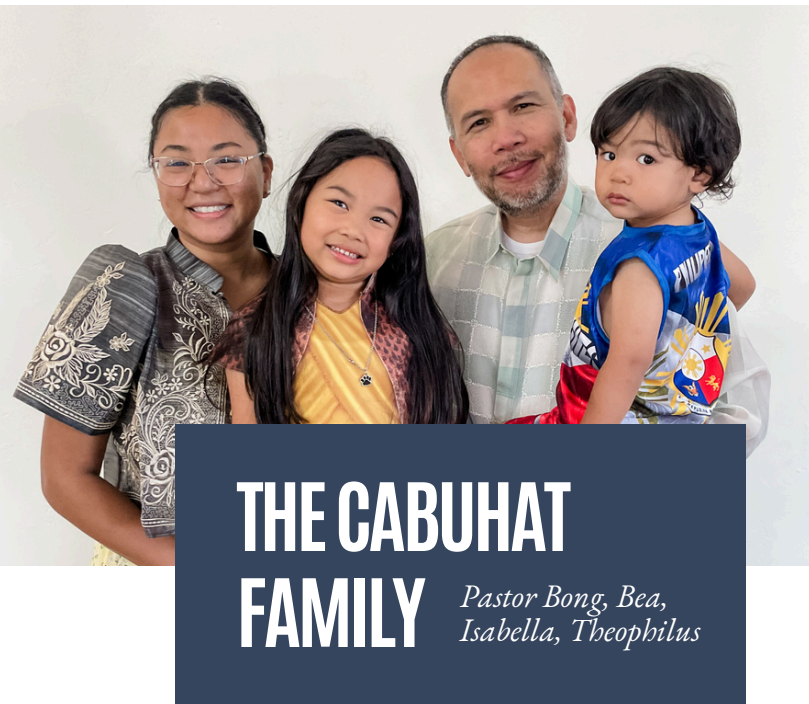

# JANUARY 2025 TRIP HIGHLIGHTS



## **The Lord of the Harvest (Matt 9:36-38).**

The Lord Jesus Christ called us to live in the Philippines in order to fulfill His mission. However, the mission is the same wherever, whenever, and whoever it may be. That is, to glorify Him through the preaching, teaching, and living out of His Gospel (Phil 1:27).

The Lord Jesus Christ is accomplishing the vision of restoring His rightful place in the hearts of people and among His churches in the Philippines (Col 1:13-18). We are amazed to see Him working in the hearts of His shepherds and opening doors for His glory (Col 4:2-4).

This past January, we went to several places in the Philippines preaching and sharing the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ according to His Word (Rom 10:17). Praise God for the hundreds of people who heard God's Word and by His sovereign will, believed in His Gospel according to Scripture (1 Cor 15:1-5).

By God's grace, we partnered with several local pastors along with their church leaders in sharing His Gospel door to door and conducting evangelistic events in their communities. # BAMBAN, TARLAC

We give thanks to God for our home church of Bonita Road Baptist Church in California who fully sponsored this week of mission by providing everything needed for training and evangelism, and also by sending believers to join us on the field.

We partnered with three local pastors and their churches who minister to the saints and to the lost on the same mountain in Bamban. A free one day Christ-centered Bible seminar was held for the members of their churches with the sole topic of *the Gospel of Jesus Christ*: why the gospel is as of first importance (1 Cor 15:1-5), what is the gospel according to Scriptures (Rom 1:16-17), and how do we share the gospel of Jesus Christ for His glory alone (Matt 28:18-20). News spread of the free training, and 10 others pastors in the area also attended and we had the joy of fellowship with them all (pictured above).

Then we joined the 3 churches in evangelism for three full days. In the mornings, we split up to share the gospel in homes and on the streets. All glory to God for opening for us a door for the Word, literally and figuratively, so we could speak forth the mystery of Christ (Col 4:3).

In the evenings, we put on an evangelistic event for their communities. We shared the gospel through the preaching of the Word, singing, testimonies, and also provided meals, sacks of rice, and Bibles to those who came, as well as gave candy to children, all in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ (Col 3:16-17).

Through these evangelistic efforts, a total of 8 new families started attending Sunday worship services, and 7 new home Bible studies were started with unbelieving families who want to know more about the gospel of Jesus Christ!

# SAMPALOC, MANILA

Our contact for this mission point was Pastor Rei who has been using our Christ-centered Gospel Workbook for the past 7 years. His church is one of many satellite locations of University Baptist Church (UBC) and they invited us to hold a 2-day Bible seminar for all their pastors and members, some of whom traveled for hours to be trained in Manila.

One day of training was dedicated to the gospel of Jesus Christ (1 Cor 15:1-5), and the other was *Christ-Centered Bible Interpretation*. Our Lord Jesus said that all Scripture testifies of Him (John 5:39) and so we searched the Scriptures together to be equipped with why we should study the Bible in honor of Christ, and how our study, teaching, and preaching of the Word should always be reveal the glory of God in Christ.

We praise God for the study Bibles that were donated for this mission point, and it was a

blessing to gift them to the pastors and their wives who attended this seminar. Some of the pastor's wives even expressed the treasure of now owning their own Bible for the first time!

During their two-worship services on Sunday, Pastor Bong was given the topic of *Christ-Centered Mission* and it was another opportunity to admonish the church to glory in the Commissioner Himself: the Lord Jesus Christ (Matt 28:18-20).

God has continued to confirm His calling for us to strengthen the church of God in His gospel. The pastors themselves told us how much they appreciated the reminder to return to their First Love, Jesus Christ. And we've already been invited back to their satellite locations to give further training in Christ-centeredness. So we are eager to continue to preach the gospel to those who are in these churches also (Rom 1:15)!

# ARAYAT, PAMPANGA

We met Pastor Rex last year when Pastor Bong was a guest preacher for a Bible conference at a seminary. Since then, he has been pleading with us to visit his church, and God made a way for our schedules to finally align. Chosen One Community Baptist Church is the only Christian church in the area, with the closest one being a church they planted which is more than a 30-minute drive away.

Pastor Bong delivered God's Word to both churches on Sunday and we enjoyed fellowship with the leaders of both churches. Pastor Rex heard of the equipping and evangelism program we did in Bamban and is requesting that we consider their area for the next one.

By God's sovereignty, the monthly fellowship for pastors and leaders of the Central Luzon Association of Southern Baptist Churches (CLASBC) was being held at his church the

following day so Pastor Bong was requested to be the one to give exhortation from the Scriptures to these men of God.

There was about 70 people in attendance and through this event we met so many more pastors who want us to go to their churches to hold our ministry programs. So much so, that our first month living in Philippines is already booked with preaching engagements!

They told us that this gathering is actually only a fraction of the CLASBC churches; their bi-annual meeting totals 700+ pastors and leaders, and when all the churches with their members get together for Resurrection Sunday once a year, they are about 3,000! We are overwhelmed at all the people God is giving us the opportunity to minister to for the sake of His gospel and for His glory alone.

# MARUGLO, TARLAC

Last year during an AOFIM seminar, we were so blessed to have met Pastor Jonar and his wife Ninita. They traveled two hours and even slept on the floor of a church just to receive free Bible training. So we set out to visit him and his church, but we didn't know how difficult it would be to get to him.

Pastor Jonar's church is from the *Barangay* or village of Maruglo near Mount Pinatubo in the province of Tarlac. Maruglo is home to many *Aeta*, an indigenous peoples of the Philippines. To get to his church we had to drive for an hour from the closest main city, then ditch our car and ride for another hour in a *kolong-kolong*, which is a motorcycle with a sidecar. Since Maruglo is located inside a Philippine Air Force Base, we had to go through 3 checkpoints before we reached their church.

We were welcomed by many women and

children who started filling up the church when they saw we arrived. Pastor Bong preached the Word of Christ, we gave out 2 boxes full of donated clothes and toys to the families, and shared a simple meal together.

We learned that Pastor Jonar knows 12 other *Aeta* pastors in Maruglo who would be willing to travel to his church to be equipped in God's Word. So we joined in prayer and submitted to the Lord our desire to grow together in the gospel of Christ, despite the challenges we may encounter in trying to minister in their area.

God-willing, Maruglo will be our first mission point in January 2026, beginning with 2 weeks of Bible training and evangelism, similar to what we held at Bamban. We pray that after this introductory mission, God will give us wisdom and direction in how we can minister to these pastors long-term.





## PRAY FOR:

- Pastor Jonar, his wife, Ninita, and their four children. Pray that the Lord Jesus would be the foundation of their marriage and household (*Eph 5:22-23*)
- Maruglo Baptist Church, that they would shine the light of gospel of Christ (*Matt 5:16*)
- The other Aeta pastors who minister in this area (*Eph 4:13*)
- God-given wisdom and discernment for AOFIM in making plans to minister in this area. For God to grant us favor with the military base and with the village officials (*Rom 1:9-12*)

But before then, we will be spending the rest of 2025 traveling around USA and Canada to share with other believers our ministry and calling to missions.

# A MOBILE MINISTRY

Once we live in the Philippines, at every Mission Point, we will **partner** with a local church for a period of 3 months to host our ministry programs. We'll **equip** the pastors and church leaders living in the vicinity of this host church by conducting free weekly Bible training while ministering to them daily. We will also partner with these churches in **evangelizing** their communities in the preaching of the gospel of Christ. After 3 months, we will **travel** to the next Mission Point and begin again with another set of pastors and churches.

In order to bring the training to the pastors and churches in need, we are praying for a Mobile Facility (a truck and a camper trailer) that will serve as our ministry headquarters and missionary housing for our family of four.

The Mobile Facility will allow us:

- **mobility** to go to any town and be in the vicinity of the churches in need, enabling us to bring the supplies and materials needed for ministry;
- **flexibility** to the host church, who will not be burdened to provide housing for us; and if needed, we can conduct ministry programs around the Mobile Facility by setting up chairs and tables under an awning; and
- **stability** for our family, especially for our young children, so they will have less difficulty adjusting to our frequent travels to different Mission Points.

**Will you prayerfully consider giving to God's work through this ministry?** We trust that our God who called us to His mission will also provide according to His will. Please partner with us in the gospel of Christ through your prayers and financial support (Phil 1:3-5).



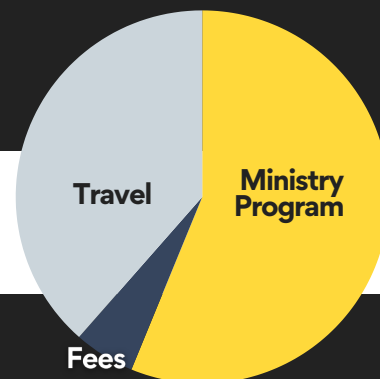
